present sustainability expert, sculptor and
green inventor Tom Flood.**

Tom is the founder of Diluvian LLC, a Seattle-based studio that primarily designs, creates and manages habitable sculptures. Using art and nature as guides, Diluvian strives to creatively integrate and synthesize natural systems in its projects by using native, sustainable materials, local companies and community resources.

Tom Flood has created a new water harvesting invention, ***The Diluvian Aquicell***, that has the potential to revolutionize how fresh or grey water can be stored. Aside from water being imperative for human survival, water as a commodity is a growing, multi-billion dollar industry. First world countries flush 70% of their fresh water down toilets and wash drains. Conserving, storing and re-using fresh water has become a major priority in the Sustainability/Green Movement.

Aside from being the founder of Diluvian, Tom Flood is an artist, sculptor, teacher and intensive urban farmer. He grew up on a farm in rural Washington and is the recipient of many public and private commissions in Seattle. For more information, please see
